

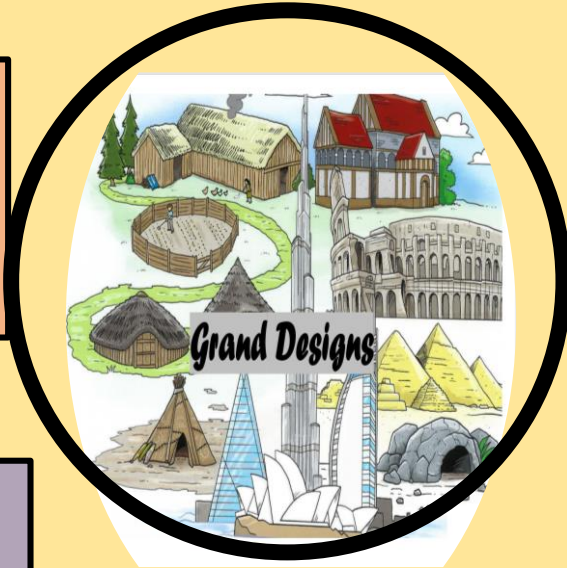
Year 3 Summer 2023 Theme: Grand Designs
