Mental health and Wellbeing

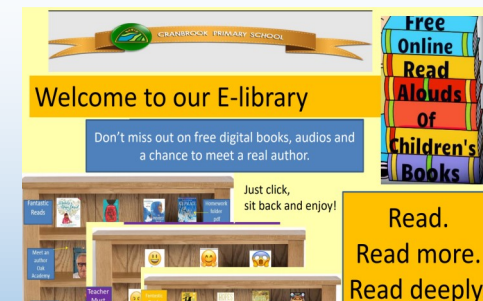
Ensure you are looking after yourself and your loved ones over this Easter break.
