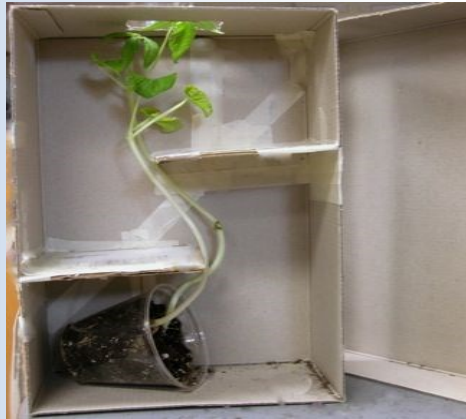


Your end of term project is to produce something to **REVIEW** and **APPLY** your learning from our Spring Theme—Our World Our Future
